WHAT EVERY CAMPER SHOULD KNOW

Do you provide evaluations? Yes, evaluations will be provided on the last day of camp at closing ceremonies for all campers. These evaluations will be an honest assessment from the UCSB coaching staff based on your potential to compete at the inter-collegiate level.

Does the Elite ID Camp provide recruiting information? There will be a panel discussion led by the college coaches in attendance to discuss the recruiting process to all campers. Further, through the evaluation process, the coaches will accurately assess your ability, and how it might translate to success at the college level. In addition, coaches use the Elite ID Camp as a recruiting tool, and many past participants are currently competing at the collegiate level. Each college coach will be provided with a profile book of all campers bio's in attendance.

What forms of payment do you accept for registration? We are only accepting major credit card payments online. In the event that you cannot register online or provide a credit card for payment, please contact us to make other arrangements.

If I am a residential camper, will I have a roommate? Campers stay in hotel rooms that are perfect for both individuals and teams. Rooms will be assigned randomly unless you request differently online before December 15, 2019. Roommate requests are not guaranteed, but we will do our best to make it happen. If you don't have a roommate request, you will be placed in a room with someone near your age. It will be a great opportunity to meet someone new! Santa Barbara Soccer Camp staff will be onsite at hotel to monitor at all times.

When is check out for residential campers? Camp will conclude at 4:00pm on Sunday. Campers will not be able to check out until the camp director has thoroughly inspected their hotel room/living quarters at 8am on Sunday. All campers can be picked up at UCSB Recreation Field on the final day at the completion of closing ceremonies.

When do I get to camp? Registration for OVERNIGHT/RESIDENTIAL campers who are staying at the Best Western South Coast Inn will be from 7:45 am to 8:15am at hotel and between 9:00 am & 9:30 am for COMMUTER/DAY campers at UCSB Recreation Center Field Turf. If you are staying overnight with your parents and making hotel arrangements on your own then you are consider a COMMUTER/DAY.

When is the day/commuter camper daily schedule? You will spend the entire day and most of the evening at camp, joining the resident campers for all activities.

If I am a day/commuter camper, should I bring anything with me to camp? YES! We recommend that you bring a daily pack with the following items: ball, water bottle, spare shirt/shorts/socks or appropriate clothing for each activity that will be described to you at registration.

Do I need any spending money? No, but you could bring up to \$35 to purchase gear.
