

**Thank you for registering for the 2024 Santa Barbara Soccer Winter ID Camp
December 21-22, 2024 at UC Santa Barbara**

Registration:

- Saturday December 21st between 8am and 9am at Robertson Field (Turf), UC Santa Barbara Campus (516 Ocean Road, Santa Barbara Ca, 93106). Park in Parking lot 16 or in parking structure 18. (See attached map). We recommend you drop your child off. If you are staying then you MUST use the ePermits on campus. They will ticket visitors if you DO NOT purchase an hourly or daily pass. The camp introduction meeting begins at **9:15am sharp at Robertson Field (Turf)**.

Camp Ends:

- Camp will end on Sunday December 22nd at 3:00pm at Robertson Field (Turf).

Health and Safety:

Health services include a certified Athletic Trainer and a doctor on call at all times. Drugs, Alcoholic beverages and tobacco products are strictly forbidden and constitute, along with general misconduct, grounds for immediate dismissal from camp without refund.

Automobiles/ Parking Rules:

Once you enter onto UC Santa Barbara campus you will need to pay at parking meter. All transportation to and from hotel on Friday & Saturday nights will be provided by the camp staff for overnight campers only.

Roommates (Residential Campers Only):

- Campers who are staying in hotel rooms. Roommates will be assigned randomly unless you request differently online before December 15, 2020. Roommate requests are not guaranteed, but we will do our best to make it happen.

Roommates Continued....

- If you don't have a roommate request, you will be placed in a room with someone near your age. It will be a great opportunity to meet someone new! Santa Barbara staff will be onsite at hotel to monitor at all times.

Cancellations:

If you must cancel, please do so as early as possible so that we can notify those on the waiting list! All online payments are non-refundable unless Santa Barbara cancels the camp.

Schedule:

If parents feel it is necessary to watch your son participate in camp; we are strongly encouraged you to ONLY attend the 9v9 games. (See attached).

Directions:

- Robertson Turf Field: Traveling North on the 101 Freeway. Exit 101 at the airport/UCSB (Route 217) off-ramp and proceed through Henely Gate at the east campus entrance. Veer right onto Mesa Road and continue to the third traffic light and turn left onto Ocean Drive; Then turn left at first traffic light into parking lot 16 and parking structure 18. The field is on your right hand side across from the parking. See map for reference points.
- Stadium Drive Field (Friday Goalkeepers Only): Traveling North on the 101 Freeway. Exit 101 at the airport/UCSB (Route 217) off-ramp and proceed through Henely Gate at the east campus entrance. Veer right onto Mesa Road and continue to the forth traffic light and turn left onto Stadium Drive (firehall on right); Then turn right at the next street (just pass the main entrance to game field/stadium). Proceed to the circle (staff will meet you here at 4:45pm sharp). See map for reference points.
- Parking- All visitors must purchase a permit to park on campus.

Payments:

- Full Payment of camp fees must be received online no later than December 15, 2024.
- For all Campers who completed registration after camp was closed on December 15th, all final payments must be made at check-in on Saturday. A separate email will be sent with these details.

Travel:

Plane: Campers have 2 options when flying by plane to and from camp.

Option 1: Fly in and out of Santa Barbara airport (SBA), a camp representative will be available to pick up and drop off campers. Option 2: Fly in and out of Los Angeles (LAX). A private company called Santa Barbara Airbus transports passengers to and from Santa Barbara to LAX. When arriving at camp on Santa Barbara Airbus, make sure to get off at the LAST stop, which is Goleta bus station. Information on the Santa Barbara Airbus schedule is available online at www.SBAIRBUS.com or by calling 1-800-423-1618. Flight & Bus arrival and departure information must be provided via email by 12/15/24.

Travel by train and/or bus:

Campers who are coming to and from camp via train and/or bus must arrive and depart from Goleta only. Train/Bus arrival and departure information must be provided via email by 12/15/24.

Checklist of things to bring:

- **SOCCER BALL** (MUST BRING)
- 2-3 pairs of socks
- Soccer cleats, Shin guards & Running Shoes (for tour)
- Water bottle (Water provide, must have containers)
- Camp T-shirt will be provided to wear during all 9v9 games
- Spending money (Recommend \$25 for dinner on Saturday)

Early Arrivals/Late Departures:

Early arrivals and late departures are discouraged. However, if a camper must arrive early or stay late, arrangements for additional nights can be made by contacting the camp director. Please email sbsoccercamps@gmail.com.

Meal Service:

Full meal service (2-meals for residential and commuter campers) is provided by the camp during the lunch hours. The meals will be pizza and sandwiches and are included in the price of the camp. If you have any food allergies you must email sbsoccercamps@gmail.com prior to 12/15/24 to accommodate your requests. Reminder, for Saturday evening dinner we will all walk (together with other campers) into IV for dinner, everyone must provide your own means to purchase dinner, we recommend you have \$15-25 for these dining options.

Communication:

We encourage communication with home if necessary. We do not allow the use of cell phones during training sessions. If you need to reach your child for an urgent

Communication continued... matter, please call the Director's cell phone (805-705-4199). Our staff will put you in touch with your camper after the session. If the matter is not urgent, please leave a message and we will be in touch. If campers have any concerns such as grouping, homesickness, illness or injury, etc., please ask your child to talk to their coach or camp director first. We are committed to making this a great experience for your child and want your child to deal with all issues and learn to communicate on own behalf.

What Every CAMPER Should Know:

We are very excited that you are going to be joining us for the Santa Barbara Elite ID Camp at UC Santa Barbara. Here are some important facts that apply to Campers.

When do I get to camp?

Registration for OVERNIGHT/RESIDENTIAL campers who are staying at the Hilton Garden Inn; a separate email will be sent directly to all campers with specifics in regards to check-in, check-out procedures, roommates and transportation. All overnight campers STILL MUST check in between 8-9:00am on Saturday.

COMMUTER/DAY campers must check in at Robertson Field Turf between 8-9:00am on Saturday..

What is my daily schedule?

Campers will spend the entire day and most of the evening at camp, we strongly recommend that all day and residential campers stay with the other campers and staff between all sessions. This will provide the best experience.

Should I bring anything with me to camp?

YES! We recommend that you bring a daily pack with the following items: ball, water bottle, sneakers, spare shirt/shorts/socks or appropriate clothing for each activity that will be described to you at registration.

Do I need any spending money?

Yes. We recommend bringing \$15-25 in spending money for dinner (Saturday) and snacks

Check Out

Camp will conclude at 3:00pm on Sunday. Campers will not be able to check out until the camp director has thoroughly inspected their hotel room/living quarters at 8am on Sunday. All campers can be picked up at Robertson Field on the final day at the completion of closing ceremonies at 3:00pm sharp.
